'Cross Stitch for All - A Beginner's Guide,' Saturday 15th July 2023
10am—2pm, £7.50 per person (Max 8 people).

Learn how to create beautiful stitched designs in this beginner's class. You will receive a needle, threads, pattern and fabric to complete your project.



'A Beginner's Guide to Dorset Buttons,' Saturday 19th August 2023
10am - 2pm, £7.50 per person (Max 8 people).

Learn about the history of Dorset buttons and the basics of how to create one of these for yourself. You will receive two base rings, thread, needle, and instructions on how to create a traditional cartwheel button.



'A Beginner's Guide to Crochet,' Saturday (TBC) September 2023
10am - 2pm, £7.50 per person (Max 8 people).

Learn the basics of crochet and how to create a crochet chain and circle including basic stitches and how to read a simple crochet pattern. You will get a crochet hook, pattern and enough yarn to finish a small project.



'A Beginner's Guide to Knitting,' Saturday 14th October 2023
10am - 2pm, £7.50 per person (Max 8 people).

Learn the basics of knitting - casting on/off, different stitches, patterns, and increasing/decreasing stitches. You will receive a pair of knitting needles, a simple pattern and enough yarn to complete your project.



'Beading Class for Intermediates,' Saturday 11th November 2023
10am - 2pm, £10.50 per person (Max 8 people).

Learn how to create a bracelet using small beads. You will receive a pattern, needle and thread and enough beads to complete your project.



'Beginner's Guide to Macrame,' Saturday 16th December 2023
10am - 2pm, £7.50 per person (Max 8 people).

Learn the basics of macrame knots and create a Christmas decoration to take home. You will be able to borrow a clipboard to work on and will receive enough yarn to complete your project.
